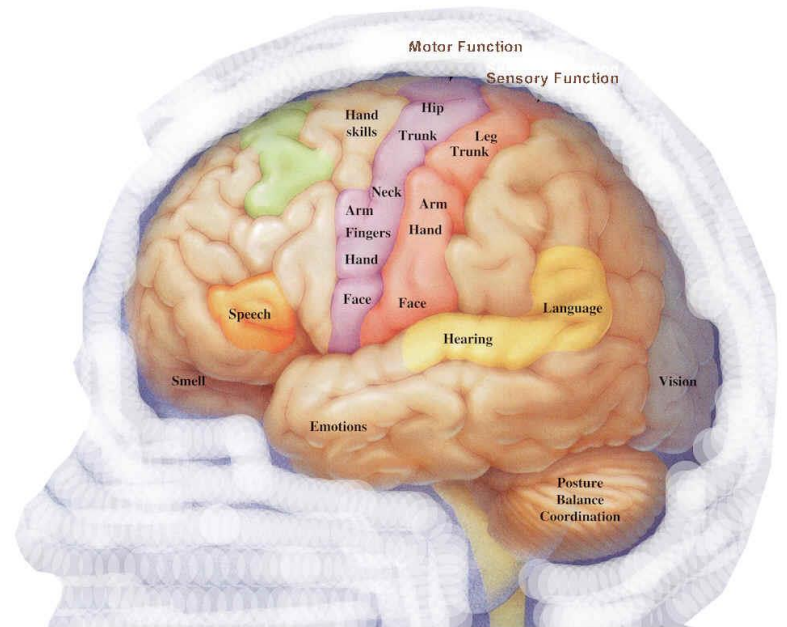

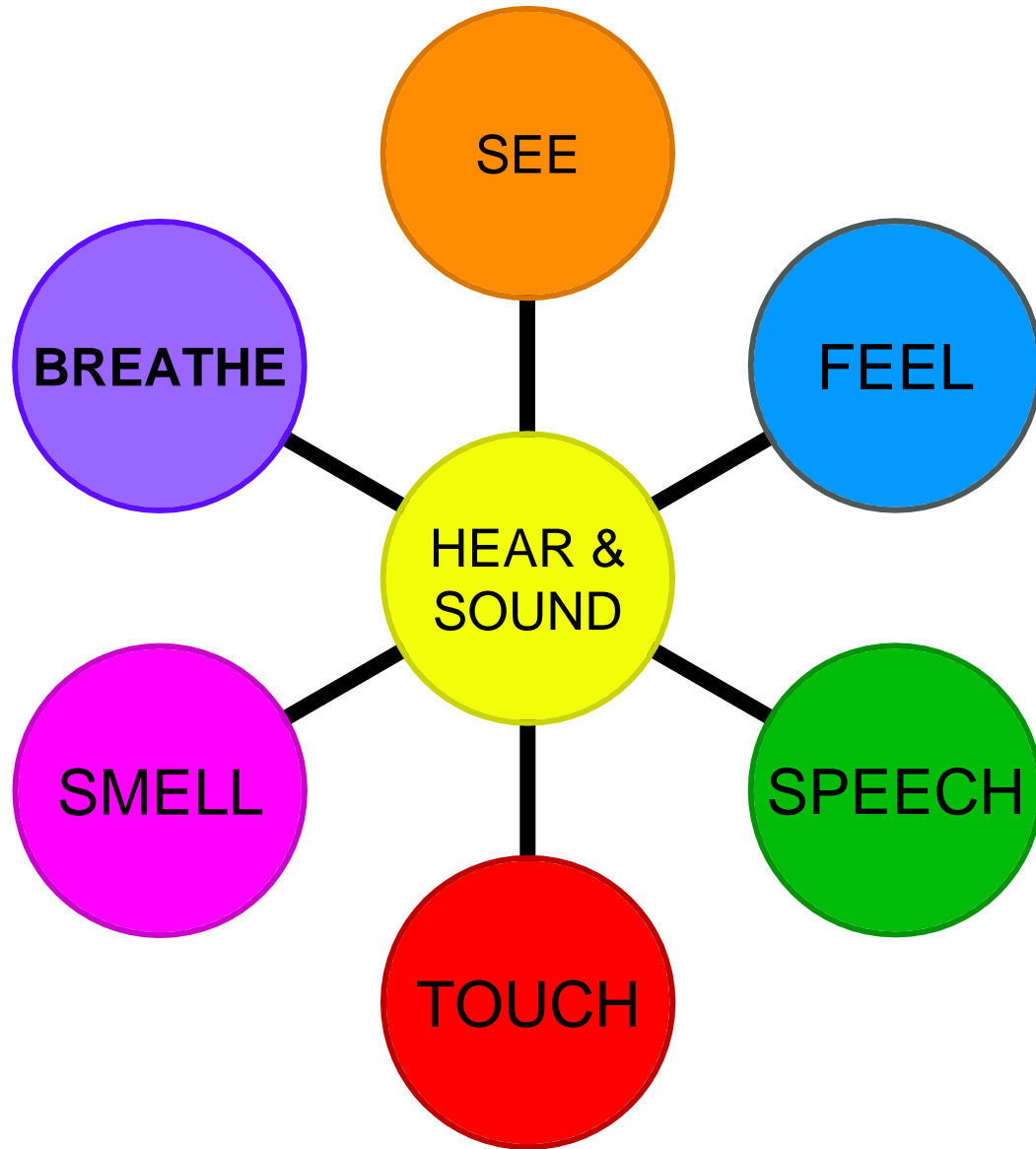
The Brain and Memory

Do you know someone who has dementia consider SPICES on second slide forward ?

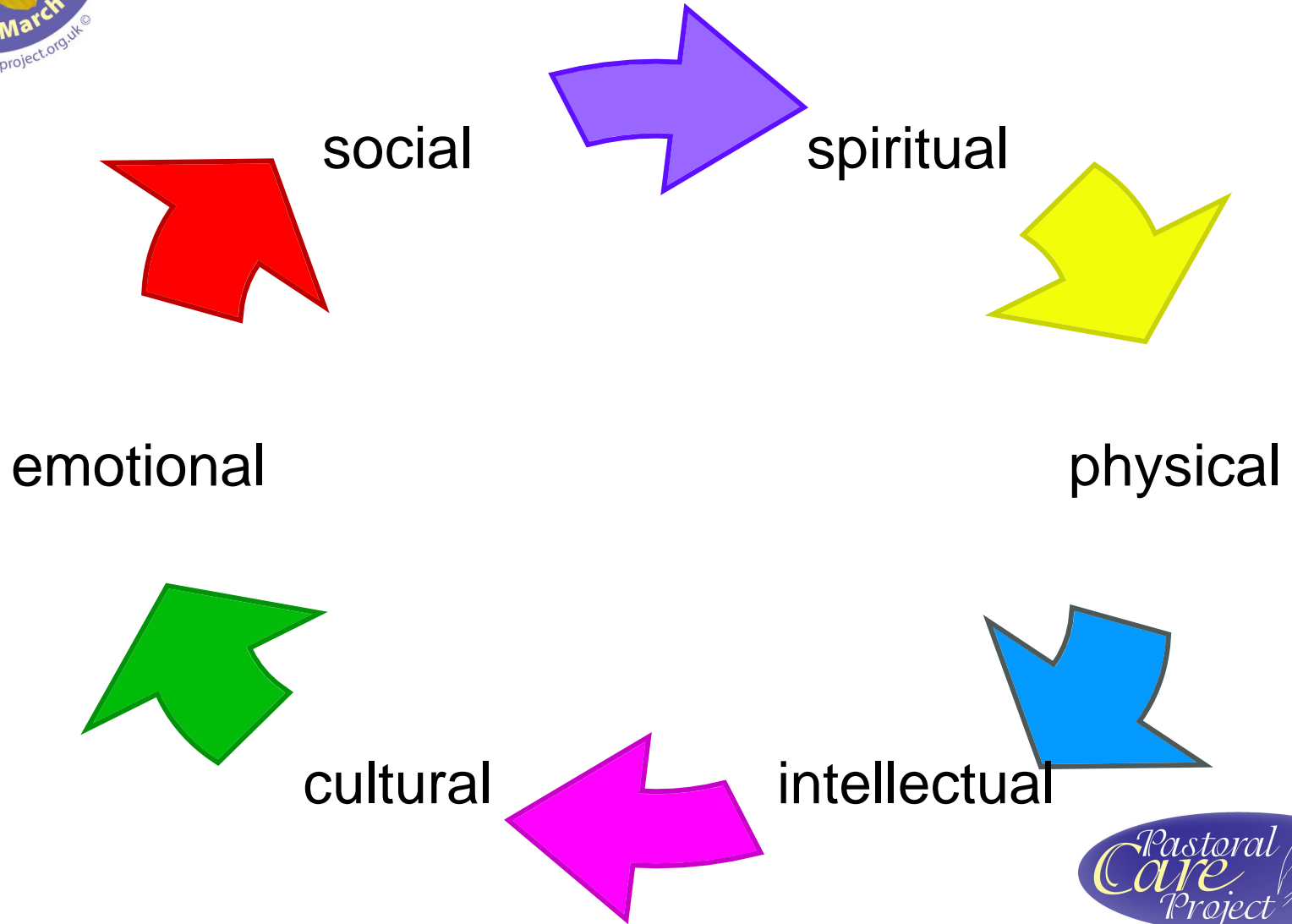
